



When refugees arrive in the United States, they come with little more than the clothes on their backs. At JF&CS, we take great pride in providing the essentials to help them begin their new lives in their new homes. For each family that arrives, we set up an entire household – everything from kitchen items to furniture to clothing.

Important Instructions:

- Clothing and small household items should be dropped off at our office – 5743 Bartlett Street, Squirrel Hill. Due to limited space, **please call ahead** to ensure we have room for your items.
- Large furniture items located within a reasonable distance are picked up by JF&CS when a new family's apartment is being furnished. **Please call us** to coordinate.

Below is a list of things we always can use. Items should be new or gently used, clean and sturdy.

Household items:

- Bowls/glasses/silverware/serving spoons/spatulas
- Pots with lids
- Mixing/serving bowls
- Baking dishes
- Working clock radios

Clothing/Bedding:

- Adult size - small or medium
- Winter coats, jackets – infant to medium adult sizes
- Mittens, hats, gloves, scarves
- Sheets/blankets/quilts for twin- or full-size beds

Furniture:

- Couches or loveseats
- Dressers
- Kitchen tables and chairs

We DO NOT accept donations of beds or pillows.
