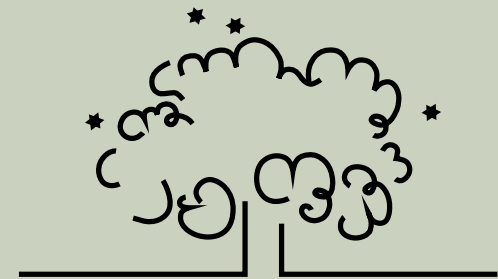

FROM AN ORGANIZATION WITH THREE VOLUNTEERS TO AN AGENCY THAT BOASTS NEARLY 2,000 VOLUNTEERS.”

Transitions are a part of life. Every day for 80 years, we have seen a multitude of life transitions at Jewish Family & Children’s Service; adults aging and needing support, unemployed people trying to find employment, families struggling to put food on their tables, people fleeing persecution in their home countries and seeking refuge in our region...and so much more.

Transitions also take place as JF&CS responds to the changing needs of our community and as leadership changes take place in the organization.

For 17 years, I had the privilege of serving as President & CEO of this incredible organization. As my tenure with JF&CS ended September 30, 2016, I am grateful to the Board of Directors of Jewish Family & Children’s Service for entrusting me with the leadership of this amazing organization, for the phenomenal staff and their inspirational work and for the many thousands of caring people who have generously given their time, money and resources to make our work possible. I am proud to have made a contribution to an organization that has changed the lives of so many thousands of our community members for the better.

True to our mission, JF&CS has found innovative ways to address major issues in our community. To mention a few, we are nationally recognized for programs such as AgeWell Pittsburgh, which helps seniors live independently in their homes; EmployAble, which helps young adults with autism or mental health challenges find and retain meaningful work; The Squirrel Hill Community Food Pantry is a model program that is addressing food insecurity; Quest Camp helps children with social and emotional challenges better adjust to school and family life; Caregiver Connection provides a low cost–high value way for seniors to get in-home care and caregivers to earn a competitive wage; and SOS Pittsburgh helps families in crisis restore their dignity and regain self-sufficiency.

During my tenure JF&CS has grown from 40 staff serving 2,000 people to 100 staff serving more than 10,000 people; from an organization with three volunteers to an agency that boasts nearly 2,000 volunteers; from an organization with no interns to one with dozens of interns contributing their skills while learning from JF&CS staff about how to utilize their talents for the betterment of our community.

This kind of growth doesn’t happen on its own. It is the result of the strong relationships between JF&CS and other community organizations, such as the Jewish Federation of Greater Pittsburgh, the Jewish Healthcare Foundation, the United Way of Southwestern Pennsylvania, The Pittsburgh Foundation and the many other foundations that care about vulnerable people in our community. Through long-lasting partnerships with other nonprofits in Allegheny County, JF&CS is able to expand its reach and impact the lives of even more people.

Though we have achieved much, there is still much more to accomplish. As JF&CS prepares for our 80th year of service, I am sure that the organization will have even greater impact on our community. JF&CS is blessed with an engaged board of directors that has carefully planned out the next steps for the future of the organization. Dr. Jordan Golin is an outstanding, passionate, experienced leader, who was chosen to be the next President & CEO of JF&CS. As such, JF&CS is well-positioned to address the emerging demographic and social challenges of our community.

I am proud of all that we have accomplished together as an agency and as a community. Thank you for being with me on this journey.

“MY WIFE AND CHILDREN AND I CAME TO THE UNITED STATES IN JANUARY. IN AMERICA, THINGS ARE SO EXPENSIVE. IT’S HARD TO MANAGE RENT AND BILLS AND FOOD. SO WE ARE THANKFUL THAT THE FOOD PANTRY IS HERE. THE FOOD IS NUTRITIOUS AND GOOD QUALITY, AND THE PEOPLE WHO WORK THERE AND VOLUNTEER ARE KIND AND RESPECTFUL.

I have a job, and my wife stays at home with our three-year old daughter. My son just started school. My wife would like to work, but childcare for our daughter would be more expensive than she could earn.

There is so much to learn in America. Where things are, how to get there. Getting our driver’s licenses, signing my son up for school, finding a job, what to do if the children are sick, everything...The Pantry is what gives us the ability to figure all of these things out while still being able to put food on our table and make ends meet.

My wife and I are both teachers and we want to find jobs in education. We hope we can earn a little more money, so things will improve and we won’t have to depend on the food pantry. We are hoping that will be soon.”

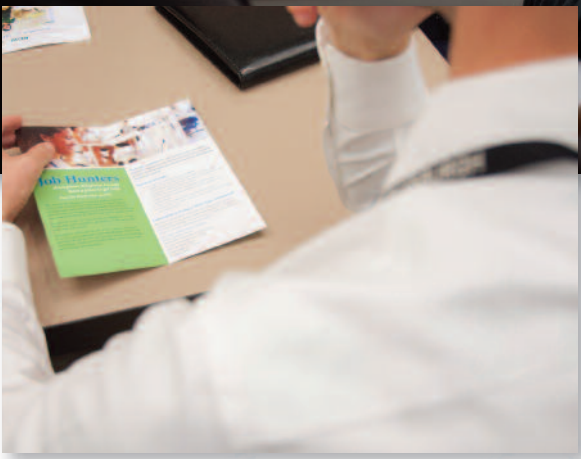

“I AM GRATEFUL TO THE CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTER FOR HELPING ME NAVIGATE HOW TO LOOK FOR A JOB IN TODAY'S MARKET. THE CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTER HAS BEEN A GODSEND TO ME BECAUSE I NO LONGER FEEL ALONE, AND AS THOUGH I'M FLOUNDERING AROUND IN THE DARK.

Through the help of my career counselor, I learned how the system works; who to contact, what gets the attention and respect of human resources, how to handle an interview, how to be more purposeful in what jobs I apply for and how. The CDC workshops are right on point; I've learned about structuring a resume to make the computer scanners happy. Searching for jobs has changed dramatically, and I needed to learn how to navigate this new world of job-seeking.

The Career Development Center has been a godsend to me because I no longer feel alone, and as though I'm floundering around in the dark. I plan to be a familiar face at the CDC until my situation changes—and I know that will be soon.”

“MY HUSBAND WAS SO ILL, AND HE WAS DISAPPEARING IN FRONT OF MY EYES. A NEIGHBOR TOLD ME ABOUT AGEWELL PITTSBURGH AND THE AGEWELL VISITS PROGRAM. I THOUGHT A FRIENDLY VISITOR WOULD BRIGHTEN MY HUSBAND’S SPIRITS.

I was so impressed because the AgeWell Visits program coordinator came out to our house. She spent a couple hours with my husband, finding out about his interests, things he liked to talk about, his needs and his personality. She took the time to get to know him. She didn’t just send any volunteer, she matched him with somebody she thought he would like.

The volunteers were a father and his son, who was studying for his Bar Mitzvah. They started coming once a month, but they all enjoyed the company so much that it increased to once a week.

My husband’s health was failing and when it was time to move him to a nursing home, they even went to see him there. They just loved him and he loved them. And when he died, they came to his funeral.

The biggest surprise was after, when they called me and asked if they could keep coming to visit me. Now the whole family, mom, dad and both children, come over a couple times a month. We play games, and I spoil them with treats. It has been a beautiful experience.”

“MY FAMILY AND I WERE IN IRAQ. WORKING AS AN ENGINEER FOR A COMPANY THAT WAS JUST A SUBCONTRACTOR OF AN AMERICAN COMPANY, EVEN ON A CIVIL PROJECT, BECAME TOO DANGEROUS. THERE WERE THREATS, PEOPLE KNEW MY CAR, WHERE I LIVED. MY WIFE AND I TALKED. WE AGREED I SHOULD TRY TO GO TO AMERICA.

I came here, legally, and immediately began working on trying to bring my family over. It took a while, but finally asylum was also granted to my wife and children. But before they could come here, her brother and father died. She couldn't leave her mother alone, and we missed the asylum deadline.

For the next two years, I traveled back and forth. I would stay in Iraq for a couple months and then come back to the U.S. The second asylum approval came, but by then my wife was pregnant, and soon our son was born. The asylum acceptance covered everyone but him. I didn't know what to do. We couldn't leave Iraq without our baby boy.

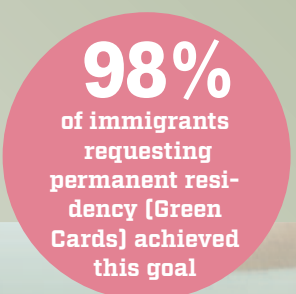
People I know told me about Jewish Family & Children's Service. For over a year and a half we waited, and I kept traveling back and forth. I was ready to give up, but JF&CS said there was light at the end of the tunnel. Throughout it all, JF&CS worked hard for us, and never forgot about us for the entire two years.

Finally, because of JF&CS, we are all here. I am lucky. I feel I did something good for my kids' futures.”

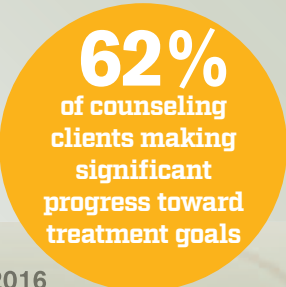

“MY AUNT AND UNCLE ADOPTED TEN CHILDREN AND HAD THREE OF THEIR OWN, SO ADOPTION WAS ALWAYS A BIG PART OF MY FAMILY LIFE GROWING UP. MY HUSBAND AND I HAD ALWAYS CONSIDERED ADOPTION, AND WHEN IT WAS TIME TO BUILD OUR FAMILY, CONCEPTION DIFFICULTIES MADE THE DECISION FOR US.

As a whole, the adoption process seemed overwhelming. When we searched on the internet, Family Hope Connection seemed like more than just an adoption agency. We liked that there was a wider array of services, supports and resources to us as potential adoptive parents, and later as a family.

Our first adoption ended up being very difficult. The staff were extremely helpful and supportive, and connected us with parents who had been through similar circumstances to lean on for support.

When we thought of adding to our family a few years later, we went back to FHC. We knew so much more about adoption and the process, thanks to the first time around with FHC.”

“I HAD EARNED A DEGREE IN BUSINESS MANAGEMENT AND WAS WORKING AS A TELLER AT A BANK DOWNTOWN, BUT THERE WAS LITTLE OPPORTUNITY FOR GROWTH. SO I DECIDED TO GO BACK TO SCHOOL AND STUDY ACCOUNTING SO I COULD ADVANCE MY CAREER AND SALARY POTENTIAL. I AM MARRIED WITH THREE CHILDREN, SO I HAD TO KEEP WORKING AND GO TO SCHOOL PART-TIME.

I heard from friends that the Central Scholarship & Loan Referral Service program was a great resource for financial aid. I applied and interviewed and received substantial financial assistance. It took 4 years, but this December I will graduate with a masters in accounting. I plan to sit for my CPA exam next summer.

The Central Scholarship & Loan Referral Service program made it possible to pursue the professional growth I was looking for, and landed me in a workplace where I am truly valued for my skills. “SEVERAL YEARS AGO, MY BROTHER WAS DEEMED INCAPACITATED AND UNABLE TO MAKE DECISIONS FOR HIMSELF. I LIVED OUT OF TOWN AND COULDN’T LEAVE MY WIFE AND FAMILY TO CARE FOR HIM TO THE EXTENT HE REQUIRED. WE NEEDED SOMEONE TO STEP IN AND MANAGE HIS CARE AS HIS GUARDIAN.

Through JF&CS’s guardianship caseworker, my brother has someone who looks out for him; who makes sure he’s taking his daily medications, who helps him live semi-independently—and who ensures his health and well-being is a priority. Even when he recently developed serious health issues and had to have major surgery, the caseworker was with him every step of the way; she made sure he was following post-surgery instructions and she accompanied him to his follow-up doctor’s visits.

This has been a very difficult time for me and my brother, but I feel lucky that we have such great support in such a fantastic organization, and that my brother is cared for like a family member, by the caseworkers at JF&CS.”

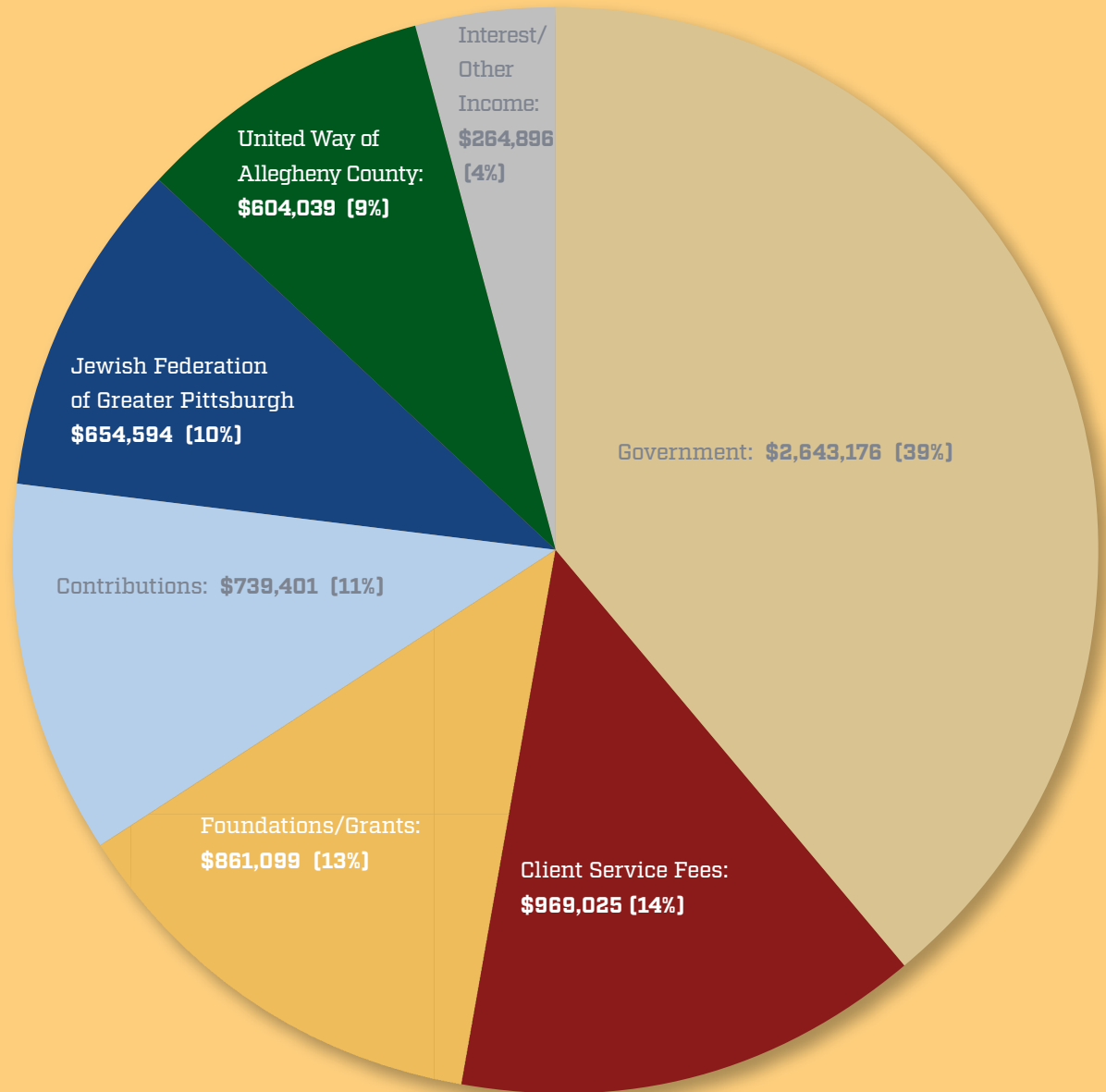
